Keilor Cemetery Expansion

COMMUNITY UPDATE | MARCH 2016

Greater Metropolitan Cemeteries Trust (GMCT) is undertaking an extension to the Keilor Cemetery to continue to provide a much-needed variety of interment options to the local community.

Updates will continue to be provided, and information available on site.

Context

The need for expansion at Keilor Cemetery was previously identified as part of GMCT's masterplanning process and the addition of over 5000 new graves will meet strong community demand for burial and memorialisation space. The extension will be built on a vacant area of land managed by GMCT to the north of Ely Court, which is bounded by the Calder/WRR Freeway ramp, Ely Court, Exchange Close and to the east of Tunnecliffe Court.

What to expect

Landscaping works will commence in April 2016; the area will become operational by early 2017.

Works under the tender agreement are set to begin midyear, however minimal impact on the public and on cemetery operations is expected.
